## THE ROLE OF SPONSOR – A CALL TO INTEGRITY

Dear Godparent/Sponsor,

The role of Godparent at Baptism, or Sponsor at Confirmation, is more than merely ceremonial. Often times in the past, we could say that the Church had this or that **requirement**. The first question is not whether or not the Church **will permit me to be a** Godparent or Sponsor, but rather whether or not **I can allow MYSELF to be one!** In other words, each one of us must ask ourselves if our own integrity allows us to stand at the Altar and make a public profession that the faith we will speak **in words** is also <u>a faith in practice!</u>

The role of Godparent and Sponsor does not command that you be a canonized saint. All of us must place ourselves within the mercy of God. We all have miles to go in Christian progress, yet we also know that sometimes it happens that members of families, who have stopped attending Mass or who rarely receive the Sacraments, are suddenly asked to fulfill the role of a Godparent or Sponsor. If you are in a similar situation, we invite you to let this moment be a real opportunity to grow in the Spirit and in your faith. You could choose to make the signing of the eligibility form (found on the form below) a real grace of change, a moment of recommitment. You could resolve to sit down with a Priest, Pastoral staff member, or a practicing Catholic family member or friend and chart a new path in your faith.

Perhaps, you are not ready for this. If you cannot bring yourself to a renewed practice of faith, then by all means, <u>be honest</u> with the friend or relative and simply request you be excused from fulfilling the role of a Godparent or Sponsor. This is what is meant <u>by a call to integrity</u>. Whatever you discern, do so by the grace.

If we can be of any assistance in you discernment or in nurturing the grace that this occasion provides for you, please give us a call. It will be a joy to walk this step with you. Thank you for your consideration, thoughts and prayers in arriving at a response to this *call to integrity*.
